

**Legal rights around home funerals in Saskatchewan (taking body home):**

**Q: Can I provide funeral services myself?**

**A:** *If you are a family member of the deceased or any other person who is not in the business of providing funeral services, and you do not receive a fee or other remuneration, you may provide funeral services, however this does not include:*

- *embalming, which can only be performed by a licensed embalmer*
- *cremation, which can only be conducted in a licensed crematorium*

*In addition, you would be required to obtain documents required by legislation prior to burial or cremation. In Saskatchewan burial of human remains can only take place in a registered cemetery.*
